QUOTE: Block times shown are approximate and cannot reflect unforeseen delays or deviations due to weather, and air traffic control. Final billing will be based on actual block times. Catering, hangaring, de-icing, customs, in flight phone, wait time and any additional services/fees will be added to the final bill. International fees are estimated and any additional costs will be billed when invoices are received. This quote is based upon aircraft and crew availability and is not confirmed until signed and payment secured. Changes to proposed itinerary are subject to aircraft and crew availability and may result in additional cost. Additional technical stops may be required for fuel, customs or other operational reasons. Quote is based on East Coast Flight Services Inc.'s selection of FBO's. Client preferred FBO's may result in additional charges. Fuel surcharge is subject to change based on market conditions at the time of flight. This quote is valid for 30 days.

PAYMENT: Full payment by wire or credit card is required seven (7) days prior to trip departure date. An administration fee of 5% will apply for any portion of or all charges for this charter debited to the credit card provided. Brokers are responsible for the collection and remittance of applicable taxes.

CANCELLATION POLICY: Domestic trip cancellations received less than twenty-four (24) hours prior to departure and international trip cancellations received less than seventy-two (72) hours prior to departure will incur a fee of two times the hourly rate in quoted aircraft plus costs incurred to position the aircraft including but not limited to accommodations, permits and processing fees. If requested resort destinations [domestic or international] require expenses to be incurred more than 72 hours prior to departure, you will be responsible for these costs, regardless of trip cancellation.

INTERRUPTED FLIGHTS: In the event of trip interruption caused by mechanical failure or other circumstances beyond East Coast Flight Services, Inc.'s control, charges will only apply on the portions of the flight completed. East Coast Flight Services, Inc will make every effort to secure appropriate alternate arrangements for the client. However, East Coast Flight Services, Inc. will in no way be liable for any cost incurred by the customer as a result of this interruption and additional charges may be assessed for the continuation of an interrupted trip.

DOCUMENTATION: Transportation Security Administration (TSA) regulations require that any passenger who appears to be 18 years of age or older present a VALID government issued photo ID to the flight crew and be cleared by the TSA prior to aircraft boarding. To avoid delays, please notify East Coast Flight Services, Inc. of passenger names and any changes to the passenger manifest as soon as possible. Passengers are responsible for obtaining and carrying all required passport and visa documentation for international travel.

OPERATIONAL CONTROL: Aircraft managed by East Coast Flight Services, Inc., are operated under FAA Part 135 Air Carrier Certificate Number EFVA140 T. East Coast Flight Services, Inc. retains operational control and ownership of all empty legs, paid or unpaid.

Contract aircraft are operated under their respective FAA Part 135 Air Carrier Certificates in which case you shall hold harmless East Coast Flight Services, Inc., against any and all losses.

JURISDICTION: This agreement and these terms are governed and construed in accordance with the laws of Maryland. The exclusive forum for any dispute shall be the state courts located in Talbot County, Maryland.

NOTIFICATIONS: HAZARDOUS MATERIAL RESTRICTIONS: Federal law forbids the carriage of hazardous materials aboard aircraft in your luggage or on your person. A violation can result in five years' imprisonment and penalties of \$250,000 or more (49 U.S.C. 5124). Hazardous materials include explosives, compressed gases, flammable liquids and solids, oxidizers, poisons, corrosives and radioactive materials. Examples: Paints, lighter fluid, fireworks, tear gases, oxygen bottles, and radio-pharmaceuticals. There are special exceptions for small quantities (up to 70 ounces total) of medicinal and toilet articles carried in your luggage and certain smoking materials carried on your person.
