Journey Aviation LLC (hereinafter referred to as "JA") agrees to provide aircraft charter services to the above named client in accordance with the attached schedule; as per the routing/legs listed and the price quote stated. This quote is based upon aircraft and crew availability, subject to slots and parking space, customs availability, overflights, landing permissions and ultimate owner approval.

Pricing does NOT include the following: catering, ground transportation, flight phone usage, WIFI internet, additional flight time due to adverse weather conditions, additional international fees, additional landings, ramp, hangar or de-icing charges. Catering and transportation charges coordinated on behalf of a broker are subject to a 15% service coordination fee. Please be advised our quotes do not include passenger duty taxes at international airports such as UKADP, Italian luxury taxes and other government-imposed passenger fees, unless specified by the sales team. These government taxes are passenger count driven and not marked up by Journey Aviation.

A valid credit card will be required to authorize items not included on this quote as stipulated above -please provide a clear copy of the front and back along with the cardholder ID. Miscellaneous charges will be billed at the conclusion of the trip and may be billed in fragments as received from third party vendors.

Should this quote be exclusive of any applicable taxes, the broker is responsible and hereby agrees to collect the FET, segment and other applicable taxes from the client and remit to the IRS.

WiFi costs will be passed on upon completion of the flight.

Interior Damage - The customer agrees to be responsible for any damage to the interior of the aircraft, including any and all costs of cleaning, restoring, repairing, or replacing materials damaged by the customer or any passenger (including pets) during the charter flight.

Smoking on Aircraft - Smoking is allowed on certain aircraft and is subject to a smoking fee. Please advise in advance if smoking is anticipated in order for us to adequately make arrangements for thorough cleaning. The undersigned acknowledges and accepts there will be a \$1,000 USD smoking fee for pre-approved smoking arrangements on authorized aircraft.

Excessive Wait Time / Passenger Delays - JA reserves the right to charge \$250 USD for each hour of excessive wait time. Once the scheduled departure time is exceeded by one hour, the charge will commence on every hour thereafter. Please note that duty time and scheduling factors do play a role in delayed departures and JA is not liable or responsible for the consequences of late departures or no-shows.

Pets / Animals - Pets may travel on select aircraft provided the necessary precautions are taken by the customer (travel bag, pet harness, international passport, etc.). A pet fee is applicable after the flight. Any interior damage will be handled as per the "interior damage" clause. Pets must remain restrained (in harness/travel bag) at all times.

Fuel / FBO Selection - JA does reserve the right to adjust the fuel surcharge on quotes booked more than 5 days in advance due to current market conditions. JA will select FBO's at each airport on this itinerary. If customer requests a particular FBO, a surcharge may be applicable and will be added to the invoice.

Confirmation - To confirm an aircraft booking, JA must receive this signed contract with a legible copy of the Credit card (front and back) and a valid ID reflecting the name on the credit card. All pertinent paperwork must be sent to consider the aircraft booked, including a confirmation from the Charter/Dispatch Department. Once received, all bookings are subject to owner approval/release.

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Aircraft Selection and Utilization - JA reserves the right to select similar (same type or better) aircraft from the fleet as well as reposition aircraft on non-live legs in order to accommodate schedules, mechanicals and/or aircraft owner trips.

Additional Crew Members - Due to safety regulations, should routing require third or more crew members, they must have an adequate rest area onboard. Client may pre-determine crew member's rest area to ensure the passengers' comfort and preferences. This can be predetermined at time of booking or during Captain briefing prior to take off.

Security - Due to Federally mandated security measures, all passengers 18 years of age or older will be required to present a valid government issued photo I.D. prior to boarding. For international travel, every passenger will require a valid passport. All passengers under the age of 18 years old will need documentation of parental authorization to travel should both parents not be present (this is regardless of destination).

The customer will be responsible for obtaining any travel authorization documents, such as passports, visas and any other documentation that may be required by the departure and/or destination government authorities. Should they fail to do this, the full charter cost would be incurred regardless if trip goes as planned or not.

Safety and Compliance - JA takes safety extremely seriously. It is imperative that passengers adhere to and follow all FAA mandated regulations and follow the instructions of the flight crew at all times. All passengers must comply with CFR § 175.10. By endorsement, the client is acknowledging compliance with Hazardous materials. Further information on exceptions shall be provided by request.

OFAC and No-Fly List Regulations - OFAC regulations prohibit transactions with certain persons and organizations listed on the OFAC website, "Terrorists" and "Specially Designated Nationals and Blocked Persons," as well as listed embargoed countries and regions. All passengers must be verified on the OFAC list as well as run through the No-Fly List. Any passengers whose name appears on either list, will NOT be allowed to travel on our aircraft under any circumstances. Names can be verified on the following website <<<https://ofac.finra.org%3e>>> prior to submitting to dispatch. Journey Aviation is not responsible for any expenses incurred due to passengers being denied boarding and travel; including cost of repositioning and/or the existing cancellation policy. It is understood that all trips booked will not be for any passengers found on neither the OFAC or No-Fly lists.

Seating - Please note that each aircraft has a certain amount of legal seats for take-off and landing. There are also weight restrictions that may affect load, despite the seating configuration. Under no circumstances, will JA allow more passengers or weight than the established and approved legal limit.

Baggage - All baggage MUST be stored in the baggage compartment. Aisles and emergency exits must be clear of all bags, purses, clothes and all personal property with no exceptions. Baggage in excess of the weight and storage capacity must be shipped separately.

Firearms and Weapons - JA must be informed if any passengers (including bodyguards/security) will be traveling with firearms or weapons of any kind. All firearms must be unloaded prior to boarding. All passengers must adhere to any and all laws, rules, regulations and orders promulgated by the FAA regarding the transportation and storage of all firearms and weapons. Likewise, the passenger must follow all instructions of the flight crew regarding the transportation and storage of all firearms and weapons.

Transient Period - JA has the right to operate the aircraft and/or mobilize its crew to accommodate maintenance, owner and recovery flights, etc. as needed during transient times. Should there be a modification to the existing contracted trip, a new Quote for Aircraft Services shall be drafted.

Payment Terms - Full prepayment required prior to departure. If payment is not received prior to departure, JA is authorized to charge the given credit card for the full amount in addition to a 5% administrative fee. Should JA not have the ability to collect payment, the departure may be delayed, and/or cancelled with the cancellation clause enforced.

Mechanicals/Weather/Unforeseen Delays - JA is not liable for expenses incurred for replacement transportation in the case of mechanicals. JA will try to supply a substitute aircraft of similar cabin-class if available and on a best-effort basis.

JA is not liable or responsible for expenses related to weather or delays out of the operator's control, including unforeseen fuel stops in the event of weather. Although crew may provide customer a "projected" flight plan (inclusive of non-stop routing), JA is not liable for any changes to that projection based on weather or unforeseen circumstances. JA is not liable for any delays or issues caused by any local government, third parties or ground handling officials who are not JA employees.

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Ice / De-Icing - Customer agrees to be responsible for all de-icing charges related to the charter from the aircraft originating point (including ferry leg to trip starting point) to its final destination. Hangar or de-icing decisions by the flight crew to remove ice off of aircraft for the safety of flight are indisputable. The actual expense will be passed on as-is and at-cost with no mark-up or added charges.

Parking / Re-Positioning due to Restricted Space - Customer is responsible for any repositioning charges to nearest airport due to lack of parking or restrictions associated with the destination airport.

Cancellation Policy (N770AW / N588TN / N588AT / N996GA / N11GW / N888HE / N585D / N599TR / N767FL)

JA's cancellation policy for all flights on N770AW / N588TN / N588AT / N996GA / N11GW / N888HE / N585D / N599TR / N767FL is 25% of the confirmed quote on signing of the contract. If cancelled within 72 hours from departure a 50% cancellation fee shall apply and 100% of the quote if cancelled within 48 hours of the departure time.

Our cancellation policy for all domestic and international one-ways is 100% upon booking. A no-show of scheduled departure time will be charged the full amount of the charter cost.

Please note that change requests to itinerary or dates once scheduled and confirmed, may not be possible contingent upon the aircraft's schedule. Cancellation fees will apply should requested revision not be possible.

Cancellation Policy for JA fleet (EXCLUDING N770AW / N588TN / N588AT / N996GA / N11GW / N888HE / N585D / N599TR / N767FL)

JA's cancellation policy for round trip flights within the contiguous United States (48 states including DC) is 50% of the confirmed quote if the flight is cancelled within 48 hours of departure time. If cancelled 24 hours from departure, a 100% cancellation fee shall apply.

Our cancellation policy for all other round-trip flights (out of the contiguous United States) is 50% of the quote if the flight is cancelled within 72 hours of departure time and 100% of the quote if cancelled within 48 hours of the same departure time.

Our cancellation policy for all domestic and international one-ways is 100% upon booking. A no-show of scheduled departure time will be charged the full amount of the charter cost.

Peak Travel Day Policy - If canceled 7 days to 72 hours of departure time of the scheduled flight, the cancellation policy is 2 flight hours. If cancelled within 72 hours of departure time, the cancellation policy is 50% of the quote. If cancelled within 48 hours of departure time, a 100% cancellation fee shall apply. The cancellation policy for all one ways is 100% upon booking. A no-show of scheduled departure time will be charged the full amount of the charter cost.

Peak travel days are November 21-December 1, December 15-31, and January 1-9.

Terms and Conditions - Client agrees that by signing this contract, JA's Terms and Conditions will be included in their contract for the acknowledgement of the passengers. Should they not be passed on to the passengers (client's client), the client (undersigned) takes full responsibility over the terms listed herein regardless of their ability to then collect or enforce the terms to the fullest extent.
